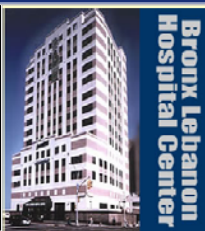

## January Grand Rounds: *Nicholas Soter on Urticaria*



**Nicholas Soter, Professor of Dermatology at New York University** is a preeminent clinician-scientist-teacher recog-

nized internationally for his work on urticaria/angioedema, vasculitis, pruritus, photosensitivity disorders, mastocytosis, and flushing.

A Texas native, Dr. Soter emigrated to Boston for his internship in medicine. He returned for the final year of dermatology residency at MGH; a fellowship in clinical immunology at Harvard Medical School; and, nearly 15 years on the Harvard Dermatology faculty.

Dr. Soter joined the Department of Dermatology at NYU in 1984. Among numerous honors, he is a fellow of the American Dermatological Association and the NY Dermatological Society. As an aficionado of the arts, especially opera and theater, Dr. Soter found an ideal home in New York.

The Unified Division of Dermatology of the Albert Einstein College of Medicine was established in the late 1960s. A residency training program started on July 1, 1970, has been the core focus of scholarship. Under the leadership of Dr. Michael Fisher, the program graduated 117 residents as of 2005. Since January 1, 2006, Dr. Steven Cohen has been the Chief of Dermatology. The professional staff as of January 2010 consists of 15 dermatology residents, 10 full- and part-time academic faculty and 25 voluntary faculty.

Clinical services provided by the division consist of ambulatory care at Jacobi Medical Center, Montefiore Medical Center and the Montefiore Children's Hospital, as well as the North Central Bronx Hospital, and Bronx-Lebanon Hospital Center. In addition to adult and pediatric services, there are sessions devoted to dermatologic surgery, a bi-weekly HIV-Dermatology Clinic, and an ultraviolet treatment unit. More than 1,200 hospitalized patients with skin disorders are seen in consultation at participating hospitals, annually, including the Montefiore-Weiler Division.

The AECOM Division of Dermatology provides continuing medical education programs for physicians in the Bronx, Westchester, and Northern New Jersey. Weekly Clinical Conferences and Grand Rounds Programs, trinal Clinicopathologic Correlation (CPC) Seminars, and special lectures are offered. Dermatology at Albert Einstein is focusing its energy and resources on excellence in teaching while developing a world-class clinical practice, and a research focus in cutaneous biology.
