

PROPOSAL FOR BIOETHICS INDEPENDENT COURSE: BIOE 5903

This course provides an opportunity for fully matriculated MBE students to design and participate in a semester-long, seminar-style independent study, under the supervision of a faculty advisor, with significant reading and writing to be completed. Students may apply for 1-2 academic credits, noting that 1 credit typically requires 15 contact hours with the advisor, with each contact hour requiring an additional 2 hours of outside work. Approval for credit will be granted on an individual basis, after review by the Center and the Registrar, upon which the student will be registered for a given term, with the faculty advisor as instructor of record. Proposals will need:

- **Detailed plan of study** (including formal syllabus with scheduled meetings, proposed readings and writing to accomplish)
- **Term paper** submitted at the end of study period.
