

PROPOSAL FOR BIOETHICS INDEPENDENT RESEARCH: BIOE 5901

This course provides an opportunity for fully matriculated MBE students to design and carry out a semester-long research project, under the supervision of a faculty advisor, with the intent to present work at a regional, national or international meeting and/or for publication. Students may apply for 1-2 academic credits, noting that 1 credit typically requires 15 contact hours with the advisor, with each contact hour requiring an additional 2 hours of outside work. Approval for credit will be granted on an individual basis, after review by the Center and the University Registrar, upon which the student will be registered for a given term, with the faculty advisor as instructor of record. Proposals will need:

- **Application form**
- **Detailed plan of research** (proposed meetings and venue for presentation/publication)
- **Academic paper** submitted at the end of research period.

Submission: All proposals should be emailed to bioethics@montefiore.org, for filing and distribution to appropriate administration.
